Dimitry Moldavchuk is an engineering professional with 23 years of diverse experience in the Aerospace and Defense industry sectors. Over the last 5 years he has been in charge of Airbus Development Programs at Zodiac Aero safety Evacuation Systems Division. As Airbus Program Manager he is responsible for overall program performance including design, test, TSO/ETSO certification and transition to Entry into Service. Dimitry had successfully developed and certified with the Aviation Authorities (FAA and EASA) the A350-900 XWB Emergency Evacuation System. Currently he manages development and certification of the A321neo ACF and the A350-1000 XWB Emergency Evacuation Systems.

Prior to joining Zodiac Aerospace he was Program Manager at Teletronics Technology Corporation. He led design and development of the Flight Test Instrumentation (FTI) systems for Fixed and Rotary Wing platforms. His team has successfully supported a number of DoD programs: Lockheed Martin F-22 Raptor, F-35 JSF Lightning II SDD and LRIP phases; Northrop Grumman B-2 Spirit enhancement orders; Boeing/Bell V-22 Osprey as well as commercial programs: Bombardier C Series.

Dimitry has moved into Program Management role from Engineering 8 years ago. Prior to this he has worked at L-3 Communications, CS-East division as Senior Member of Engineering Staff at first acting as Hardware Engineer responsible for circuit and firmware design and test, later as System Engineer supporting deployment of the new products and technologies within Federal Government markets (DoD, Intel community, other US Government customers) and finally as Lead Application Engineer supporting a broad line of Information Security products.

Dimitry holds BSEE and MSEE from Drexel University and Project Management Professional (PMP) certification from Project Management Institute (PMI). He has taken the Advanced Management courses from the Defense Acquisition University and MBA certification program in Project Management and Business Development from Walden University. Dimitry has successfully completed FAA Aircraft Certification and DER application process training. He has also completed Supply Chain Management course through APICS and Lean Six Sigma training sponsored by ASQ.

Dimitry is active in numerous professional and trade organizations including SAE International, IEEE, PMI: Delaware Valley, NY City and Moscow (Russia) Chapters, AHS, HAI and AUSA.
